As we head towards fall and shorter golf days outside, we'd like to remind everyone that the season can be extended inside the Clubhouse at RCC! ### COURSE UPDATES



Hello, I'd like to do a brief update on the work and upgrades that we will be performing on the golf course this fall. As I believe we covered already, the 3rd tee (blue / white) and both 13 white tees will be re-surfaced with new mix and sod in Mid October. Those tees will then be removed from play for the remainder of the season as well as the winter. We will provide temporary tees for the off season on both holes.

In addition to the tee renovations, we will be entering into some extensive tree removals on the third hole to aid in airflow for the second green as well as the third tee area. We will have several trees removed on the left of the third fairway in order to eventually shift the fairway to the left and away from the highway.

Currently we have for too many balls entering the lanes of 422. While it is difficult to eliminate all balls entering 422, we feel it is our obligation to make every effort to minimizing the issue. Once we enter winter, we will be adding some plant material to the current right side of the fairway to help deter the attempt to use the right side of the hole.

Wait, there's more! We have several other trees around the property slated for removal, but you'll have to check in every once in a while to see which ones. We also are well aware that several tee shots throughout the course have been subject to encroachment over the last few years. We are making a strong push to eliminate the blocked shots with selective pruning throughout the property.

Hopefully we have addressed a good bit of the tree issues without going "Oakmont". Thanks for the support and feedback, and enjoy your fall.



#### BE KIND TO OUR COURSE!

Learn How To Repair a Ball Mark





CHOOSE WISELY Use a pointed object, a ball mark repair tool is recommended.



Push Don't Pry Starting from the sides, gently push & stretch the turf to the center of the mark.



Work Around Work around the mark until it is filled in. Avoid lifting and twisting the turf harshly.



FINAL TOUCH Use your putter to lightly tap down the mark. Fix other marks in addition to yours.
