


Course News

UPCOMING AERATION WORK SEPTEMBER 8-10

We will be aerating the greens Monday through Wednesday, September 8–10. Core aeration is one of the most important practices for the long-term health of our turf. By removing compacted soil and replacing it with sand, we allow for better gaseous exchange, water infiltration, and improved drainage throughout the root zone.

Fall is the ideal time for this work, as temperatures are more predictable and recovery is quicker. Core aeration provides lasting benefits compared to solid tining, which only offers short-term relief until the holes close. Going forward, our plan is to solid tine in the spring and core aerate each fall. Because the greens had not been cored in previous years, we did perform the process this past spring, and we will be repeating it again this fall to ensure we build strong, deep root systems — not just shallow roots two inches below the surface.



You may recall some of the damage seen in the fairways this year. Excessive rainfall could not percolate through the compacted soil profile, leaving water to pool on the surface and causing turf loss. To correct this, we will also be aerating and overseeding fairways in the coming weeks. This work removes thatch and compaction, creating a more porous soil column that improves drainage and strengthens turf health for the long term.

These efforts are an essential investment in the overall playability and condition of the course. Thank you for your patience and support as we continue these important improvements.







BE KIND TO OUR COURSE!

Learn How To Repair a Ball Mark





CHOOSE WISELY Use a pointed object, a ball mark repair tool is recommended.



Push Don't Pry Starting from the sides, gently push & stretch the turf to the center of the mark.



Work Around Work around the mark until it is filled in. Avoid lifting and twisting the turf harshly.



FINAL TOUCH Use your putter to lightly tap down the mark. Fix other marks in addition to yours.
